The Competition Rules of International Traditional Karate Federation (ITKF)  
shall be in effect at all competitions of Bhima Cup.

#### A. Fukugo, Definition :

A synthesis of Kumite and Ki-tei, composed form (compulsory form)

#### B. Kata :

Kata competition demonstrates Traditional Karate-do Kata through individual,  
synchronization and application of Kata (Kata-No Bunkai)

Competitors shall be required to select at least two Kata only from the following :

#### C. Kumite (Sparring) competition

Kumite competition consists of a match between two persons free sparring without  
contact. Winner is determined when technique meets requirements of Todome-waza  
(finishing blow) which combines correct timing, Mawai (effective distance) and  
designated target zone. If no Todome-waza, winner is competitor with highest  
number of points received for effective techniques and for opponents penalties.  
Kumite competition is divided into two events : Kumite Individual and Kumite Team

#### D. Enbu : Sequence of Competition

- Two person team (man-man) demonstrates offense and defense within competition  
area with winners based on highest scores.
- Offense and defense demonstrate choreographed sequences for period of one  
minute (+ or - 5 seconds). Time is calculated from point at which either competitor  
starts to move and continues until both competitors return to Shizen-tai or directly to  
Sei-za (formal floor sitting position).

## **Recommendation of The Revival Meeting of AOTKF**

We, the official representatives of National Organizations of Traditional Karate have assembled on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of January 2011, at Jakarta, Indonesia, to discuss on reviving Asia Oceania Traditional Karate Federation (AOTKF).

We solemnly commit ourselves to promote AOTKF as a regional organization of International Traditional Karate Federation (ITKF) that will advance the development and unity of traditional karate in Asia Oceania.

We hereby recommend the followings:

1. The adoption of revised constitution and rules of AOTKF and ITKF.
2. To confirm the establishment of AOTKF secretariat at Jakarta, Indonesia.
3. To hold the regional camp in which training, examination, and certification of coach, judge, and examiner will be conducted under the qualified Sensei
4. To hold the Traditional Karate BHIMA Cup in Indonesia at the end of the year 2011 (November). Each team consists of maximum 7 athletes, only male category.

Host country is allowed to make up to 8 teams if participating country is less than 8 teams (only male category).

5. The next Conference and Championship will be held on the year of 2013 in India with date and place to be decided upon later.
6. We also invite ITKF members, Associate members & non-members to come and join AOTKF and become a regular member of Traditional Karate.
